These programs are for youth with disabilities receiving services from CLBC, offered in a day camp format and contingent upon annual funding renewal.

WHAT TO BRING DAILY

YOUTH CLUB

In addition to our Summer Youth Recreation, People In Motion also provides the community with Active Living Programs, including a Youth Club.

This program is financially supported by Variety - The Children's Charity. The Youth Club participates in three outings monthly, and runs from September through June. Transportation is provided by the People In Motion paratransit bus.

MEMBERSHIP

Active Living Program participants are required to have a current People In Motion membership (\$10 individual, \$15 family).

A People In Motion membership also gives you an opportunity to be a voting member, receive newsletters, rent Cedar Creek Camp, participate in our various workshops, and much more!
